On November 20, 2008, Edward W. Merrow, a director of MAINSTREET BANK (the “Bank”), submitted his resignation as a director of the Bank, effective immediately, in a letter emailed to the Secretary to the Bank’s Board of Directors (the “Board”). Mr. Merrow resigned from the Board in disagreement with a Board decision to permit non-independent Board members to serve on the Board’s Nominating Committee. A copy of Mr. Merrow’s resignation letter is attached as Exhibit 17.1 to this report.

Immediately prior to his resignation, Mr. Merrow served as a member of the Audit and Nominating Committees of the Board and served as Chairman of the Compensation Committee of the Board.

On November 25, 2008, William B. Wrench, a director of the Bank, submitted his resignation as a director of the Bank, effective immediately, in a letter emailed to Barbara Davis Blum, Chairman of the Bank’s Board. Mr. Wrench’s letter states that he resigned from the Board as a result of differences in concepts of governance between himself and a majority of the Board. The Bank believes that the differences referred to by Mr. Wrench relate to the Board’s decision to permit non-independent Board members to serve on the Board’s Nominating Committee. A copy of Mr. Wrench’s resignation letter is attached as Exhibit 17.2 to this report.

Immediately prior to his resignation, Mr. Wrench served as a member of the Loan Committee, Asset Liability Committee (ALCO) and Nominating Committee of the Board.

The Bank and the Board are grateful to both Mr. Merrow and Mr. Wrench for their significant service to the Bank and wish them well in their future endeavors.
